

Outdoor handicap dozen scores

This table is adapted from the GNAS handicap tables. I have done some rounding up and down.

The idea is to give archers a rough idea how well they are doing at each of the imperial distances, considering the handicap they have achieved.

I have chosen to use the handicap range 40 to 70 as almost all our club archers with a current outdoor handicap fall into this range. The choice of distances covers those required for these archers if shooting an imperial 12 dozen round (York/Hereford/Bristol).

My current outdoor handicap is 53.

Having analysed my shooting last season I found this:

Distance	Average per dozen	Lifetime best
100	15	44
80	30	56
60	56	72
50	67	88
